The mentoring program for Initial Practice Registrants (IPRs) is based on the Self Assessment Tool (SAT). For this reason when IPRs first become General Members, they are given a grace period in which they are not required to complete the SAT. As of January, following the date the IPR becomes a General Member, they are required to complete their SAT and are eligible to be one of the 250 members who are selected annually to submit their SATs to CASLPO. So for example, if the IPR becomes a General Member in February, 2012, they may wait until January 2013 to go online and complete their SAT.

However, new General Members are encouraged to review the SAT online as soon as possible so they are better prepared to complete it when required.

- User Name is your registration number
- Password is your last name
