THERE ARE SOURCES FOR HEARING AID FUNDING OTHER THAN ADP¹

You are likely aware that the provincial funding program through the Assistive Devices Program (ADP) funds hearing aids but you may not know that there are other additional sources of hearing aid funding for individuals who cannot afford hearing aids even with the \$500 per ear grant from ADP. For example:

- Charitable and service organizations such as the Kiwanis Club and The Royal Canadian Legion
- Employment and Social Development Canada
- Canada Pension Plan Disability Benefit
- First Nations and Inuit Health Branch (FNIHB)
- Veterans' Affairs
